



## Short guide to submit your ICANS 28 paper to EPJ AP or EPJ PV

**ICANS 28 conference papers will be published in two journals of the EdP Sciences group.**

Papers related to “Disordered Semiconductors: Physics and Applications” will be published in a special issue of EPJ Applied Physics (EPJ AP).

The Guest Editors for this issue will be Jean-Paul Kleider, Erik Johnson and Rudolf Brüggemann.

Papers related to “Disordered Semiconductors and Photovoltaic Applications” will be published in a special issue of EPJ Photovoltaics (EPJ PV).

The Guest Editors for this issue will be Marie Gueunier-Farret and José Alvarez.

Deadline for submissions: September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019

### 1) Author Identification

To submit your paper to **EPJ AP**, go to the homepage of the journal:

<https://articlestatus.edpsciences.org/is/epjap/home.php> and choose “submit a paper” in the menu.

To submit your paper to **EPJ PV**, go to the homepage of the journal:

<https://articlestatus.edpsciences.org/is/epjpv/home.php> and choose “submit a paper” in the menu.

You’ll first have to get identified; if you have already submitted a paper to EPJ you need your author ID, otherwise you have to register to get an author ID (which is the same for all the journals of EPJ Sciences).
